Enable Users to set preference for default ICD code set


Users with access to the Account Setup screens can now set an ICD Default in ProviderSuiteWebApp > Setup > General > ICD Default with the options of Neither, ICD-10 or ICD-9. The initial setting will be ICD-9.



Claim Entry Screen

The ICD Codes Option on Claim Entry screen will be defaulted to ICD-9. User can switch between ICD-9 and ICD-10 by selecting the radio buttons and pressing Update.


The code entry box will be enabled as soon the user selects one of the radio button and the user will be able to enter the codes as per the selected ICDcodes options.



Pre-Auth Screen

Similarly, Default value in the Pre-Authorization screen will be ICD-9. User can override by

selecting one of the options ICD-9 or ICD-10 to enter the code range.

The queries used for the Claims by DOS with CPT Detail, by Patient' and 'Claims by DOS/Accounting Date with CPT Detail' reports have been optimized to allow larger date ranges to be used.

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


Billing Manager Applet

Add ICD-10 Support to Pre-Auth Screen

- The label has been changed to ICD Codes.
- Separate radio buttons for ICD-9 and ICD-10 codes have been addded.
- The screen logic has been updated to check for ICD-10 code validity




Enhance Billing Manager "About" Dialogue Box

Update menu structure in Billing Manager

- Patients, Companies, or Referring Providers, previously under Practice Management, have been moved to a new top-level menu item named Setup.
- The Accounting sub-menu, previously under Practice Management, is now its own top-level menu, still named Accounting.
- The Reports item, previously under Practice Management, is now its own top-level menu item, still named Reports.
- The Print item, previously under Practice Management, is now its own top-level menu item, still named Print.
- The GEMs Search feature, previously under Practice Management, is now its own top-level menu item, still named GEMs Search. This is a tool that helps crosswalk between ICD-9 and ICD-10 diagnosis codes. Developed by CMS, the General Equivalency Mapping (GEM) database provides suggested crosswalks between the two code sets. The GEMs tools is also available on the Billing Manager > Claim Details screen when selecting ICD codes for use on the claim. - Logout has been renamed Exit and moved from under Practice Management to the toplevel menu
